

JPN slangs	Pronunciation	Meaning
あざす	Azásu	Short for thanks without the politeness
アがる	Agaru	To be hyped up
アツい	Atsui	Hot / cool things
あり得ない	Arienai	No way
イケイケ	Ike-ike	Trendy, fashionable (could be sarcasm)
イケメン	Ikemen	Good looking guy
生きる	Ikiru	Internet slang used in place of the word 'die', which is used for negative expressions such as when you are having a bad day.
ウザッ	Uza	Annoying
ウケる	Ukeru	Hilarious
うまっ	Uma	Really delicious, or really good at something such as playing guitar, piano, could also be sports
えぐい	Egui	Crazy, insane, can be used for a negative context
エモい	Emoi	"I'm moved" or "I'm touched"
オワタ	Owata	The end! Fucked up! It's usually used for a negative situation
推し	Oshi	My favourite, being a fan of someone especially idols, musicians or people who perform in front of people
鬼	Oni	Means something like 'devil'. Totally irritated. The Japanese word 超 (chou) is also used in a similar manner
草	Kusa	"lol" in Japanese chat rooms
蛙化	Kaeruka	Means ick. When someone does something, usually small, that makes you lose interest in them. This is a trend word among young
クソ	Kuso	Shit
キモい	Kimoi	Disgusting, unpleasant. A shorter version of 気持ち悪い (Kimochigawarui)
きまず	Kimazu	A shorter version of きまずい (Kimazui). Uncomfortable/awkwardness
ググる	Guguru	Googling
ゲコ	Geko	Someone who can't drink, non-drinker, temperate man
ざる	Zaru	Someone who can drink unlimitedly
スベる	Suberu	Someone's talk is not interesting, a joke with a missing punchline
それな	Sorena	A response, it means "I know, right?"
ダサっ	Dassa	Or ダサい (Dasai) means poor; low-grade; trivial; insignificant; worthless. Can be used both for situation and people
ちる	Chiru	A relaxed state of affairs" or "feeling pleasantly calm"
ツンデレ	Tsundere	Someone is initially harsh personality who gradually reveals a warmer, friendlier side over time
ドン引き	Donbiki	"be very put off by something eww or gross" or "very turn me off"
とりま	Torima	Anyway, for now. We usually use this in text conversation
飛ぶ	Tobu	Internet slang, means getting high
泣	Naki	Crying
泣ける	Nakeru	To shed tears, to be moved to tears
爆	Baku	A short for 爆笑 (bakushō) meaning "to burst out laughing"
バリピ	Paripi	Someone who is a party animal
ビビる	Bibiru	To feel nervously afraid or daunted
マジない	majinai	マジ=Really ない=impossible! It can be used for a negative context when you feel disappointed
ムカつく	Mukatsuku	Annoying
盛る	Moru	To exaggerate (a story) or to beautify (one's appearance in a photo)
ワンちゃん	One-chan	Means "there is a chance/possibility"
ワロタ	Warota	Laughed
www	www	Internet slang. Means "hahahaha"
